



## **SCREENING OPINION**

### **THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) (AMENDMENTS) REGULATIONS 2006**

**Site: Former allotment site adjacent Energy from Waste facility, London Road, Coventry**

**Description of Development: Proposed new Energy from Waste facility with 350,000 tonne annual capacity**

The City Council has been requested by letter (and accompanying plan ref Figure 1) from Simon McKee of Enviros dated 30 June 2009 but received by email on 3 July 2009 to adopt a screening opinion as to whether the above development is Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) development.

Schedule 1 of the Regulations describes those developments where EIA procedures apply. Category 10 includes waste disposal installations for the incineration of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 100 tonnes per day.

The proposed development will involve the incineration of non-hazardous domestic waste at a facility with an annual capacity of up to 350,000 tonnes per year. The proposed development will therefore exceed the threshold set out in Category 10 and therefore is EIA development

### **CONCLUSION**
