







KS2: Percent attaining Level 4+











KS2 English: Percent attaining Level 4+




KS2 Mathematics: Percent attaining Level 4+




KS3 English: Percent attaining Level 5+




KS3 Science: Percent attaining Level 5+



KS3 Mathematics: Percent attaining Level 5+




KS3 ICT: Percent attaining Level 5+



KS4 GCSE/GNVQ: Average Total Points attained by Y11 Students (uncapped)




