Who do we train?

Adults aged between 18-65 years old accessing:

- All Age Disability Team
- Mental Health Services
- Adult Social Care
- Agencies funded by the Coventry City Council

Young people aged between 12-25 with special educational needs, in receipt of transport and accessing:

- Special Educational Need (SEN) Schools in Coventry
- Careers Advisory Service
- Post 16 Education (College)

How do people access the service?

We accept referrals from departments within Coventry City Council

There are three ways you may refer young people to our service:

For 12-19 year olds attending SEN schools please contact your school directly.

For people over 16 with special educational needs but not attending SEN schools via your careers advisor. For people over 16 with special educational needs attending college via your advisor or the SEN Team on **024 7683 1614**.

For adults aged 18-65 you may refer to the Independent Travel Team via your Adult Social Care Team.

Who are we?

We are the Independent Travel Team (ITT) and we are based within the All Age Disability Team of Coventry City Council. We offer a city-wide service.

What do we do?

We train people how to travel safely and independently. We work in schools, colleges and in the community. Travel training is part of the school curriculum.

How do we do it?

- We offer training in practical skills required to travel independently
- We manage and assess risk by teaching safe practice, road safety and personal safety
- The agreed route will be specific and tailored to meet the individuals needs
- We support people to build on their skills and develop their confidence
- We work at the pace of the individual
