What you need to know

■ Universal entitlement

All 3 & 4 year olds are entitled to up to 15 hours FREE early education over 38 weeks (570 hours)

■ Extended entitlement

Working parents who meet the criteria could be entitled to an extra 15 hours (570 hours) free early education for their 3 & 4 year olds.

■ You can use more than one childcare provider for your entitlement

■ Additional hours can be taken in and out of term time

What you need to do

■ Go to www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to apply and if you are eligible you will get an eligibility code. You will need to do this the term before you would like to use the additional hours.

■ Extended entitlement

Take the eligibility code, your national insurance number and the child's date of birth to a childcare provider. They will be able to tell you how they are offering the extended entitlement when they validate your details.

■ Ask the childcare provider about any extra charges that may apply in addition to the FREE hours or services.

Childcare providers include: Day Nurseries, Playgroups, Childminders, School Nurseries and Out of School Clubs that are registered with both Ofsted and Coventry City Council to offer entitlement places.
