

## COVENTRY CITY COUNCIL CAR PARK SEASON PASS TERMS & CONDITIONS OF USE

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1. The Season Pass is solely for the pass holder's use and is not transferable to any other person or vehicle. The use in any other vehicle will be deemed to be misuse and may result in the vehicle being issued with a penalty charge notice and the pass withdrawn. No refunds will be issued to customers in the event that season passes are withdrawn as a result of misuse.
2. It is the pass holder's responsibility to be fully conversant with the Terms and Conditions relating to the use and the City Council's car park regulations which are displayed in the car park. Vehicles must be parked in accordance with the regulations and restrictions in the car park. Failure to do so may result in a penalty charge notice being issued to the vehicle.
3. Vehicles are parked at the owner's risk and Coventry City Council is not liable for any loss or damage to any vehicle or property.
4. It is the pass holder's responsibility to ensure the correct vehicle registration number is assigned to the season pass and the parking permit. An incorrect vehicle registration number may lead to the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice.
5. When parked in a Pay and Display car park, the PDF permit and the season pass card must be displayed together in the front windscreen of the vehicle where they must be clearly visible from outside the vehicle. [It doesn't need to be displayed in Pay on Foot (barrier controlled) car parks.]
6. The pass holder must return the pass card to Coventry City Council, Parking Services if it is not renewed, or has expired. The Council may continue charge the customer to indemnify the City Council against any unauthorised use of the Season Pass if it is not returned. Permits are only valid for use in line with the expiry date shown on the pass and permit.
7. The Season Pass is for use in the designated car parks during Monday to Sunday (including Bank Holidays) between 06:30 – 19:30. It does not guarantee / reserve a parking space in the car parks.
8. The pass does not allow the vehicle to be parked on the road or where parking restrictions are in place.
9. The Council is required by law to share personal data to help the detection of fraud. Consequently, this authority is under a duty to protect the public funds it administers and to this end may use the information you have provided for the prevention and detection of fraud.
