Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request ID: REQ05409

Thank you for your request for information relating to Developments put forward to the east of University Hospital

Your request and our responses are outlined below:

Within the last nine months a large scheme involving new accesses off the A46 to serve the proposal for 900 houses and an new 1400 place car park on the immediate east of The University Hospital was put prward by the stakeholders of this development. The access/es also included facilities to some 200 acres of development on the east side of the A46.

The cost was estimated in many tens of millions of pounds and quoted in the likelihood that Highways England would not be partner to the expense

Could you let me know if these proposals have been considered by The Council and or any of its departments and the result of any deliberations.

Land to the east of University hospital (but west of the A46) sits within Coventry's administrative boundary. The majority of this land is known as Waslgrave Hill Farm and is allocated in the Coventry Local Plan for approximately 900 homes. This is to incorporate new junction arrangements on the A46 at Clifford Bridge and additional access to the hospital.

We therefore do not have to provide the information as per Section 21 of the FOIA.

Land to the east of the A46 is with Rugby Borough Councils administrative boundary. We therefore can confirm that we do not hold this information and are advising you as per Section 1(1) of the Act. Further inquiries relating to that land should be made to the Borough Council.
