## Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request ID: REQ05577

Thank you for your request for information relating to Woodlands School Land Enquiry.

Your request and our responses are outlined below:

I would like to know if any company or business has requested information or registered interest in the old Woodlands School land for the purpose of developing a sports stadium.

Section 21 FOIA provides that:

*"(1) Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant otherwise than under section 1 is exempt information.* 

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1)—

(a) information may be reasonably accessible to the applicant even though it is accessible only on payment..."

The Council confirms that it holds the requested information but that the information you have requested is in the public domain, notably in the press. Please note that the Council is not responsible for information on third party websites.

As a result, I believe that the information is already reasonably accessible to you and is therefore exempt from disclosure. We therefore do not have to provide the information as per Section 21 of the FOIA. This exemption is not subject to the public interest test.
