RE: PPC/053 COATING ACTIVITY, BROWNS LANE

Further to clause 6.1 of the above permit, we wish to demonstrate compliance with the Solvent Emissions (England and Wales) Regulations 2004 by use of a Solvent Reduction Scheme.

The data for the past six months is as follows:

Target emissions = total mass of solids $x \cdot 1$

= 138,895.98 litres

12 monthly actual = Total input of solvent - total waste solvent collected

Solvent emission = 179.930 38 - 82,345.84

= 97,584.54 litres

Target emissions > 12 monthly actual solvent emissions
Therefore, compliance with reduction scheme is achieved

As we were compliant for the past year, and there are no anticipated changes in the process in the coming months, we anticipate being compliant for the next twelve month period, and will provide this data in January 2009.

As per our previous years' agreed request, (to put only our general summary of the compliance to the reduction scheme on the public register and to keep the attached supporting information confidential in your own records), please find attached the supporting data to demonstrate compliance with the reduction scheme. This specifies the materials used on site, the solid/solvent content of each material and total 12 monthly usage to demonstrate compliance with the reduction scheme
