**Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR)**

Thank you for requesting information about 7A Rowleys Green Lane. The Council received your request on 8 August 2014 and has considered it under the above legislation.

Following careful consideration, the information you requested relating to planning is being withheld as it falls under the exception at Regulation 6 (1)[a] EIR, which relate to information already publicly available and easily accessible in another form or format.

The recent documents the Council have (dated this year) are being withheld as they fall under the exception in Regulation 12 (5)[b] EIR. The Council does not hold historical enforcement records which relate to the site.

In applying this exception we have had to balance the public interest in withholding the information against the public interest in disclosure.

It has been established that the Council does not hold any other information in connection with the alleged footpath and are informing you as required by Regulations 12(4) of the Regulations.
