Thank you for requesting information about Mosquito devices, which the Council received on 9th April 2015. Your request has been considered under the above legislation.

You have specifically requested:

All of these questions pertain to an electronic device known as a Mosquito device: an instrument that can be installed on buildings or structures and upon activation produces high pitched sounds that only young people can hear.

- 1. Has your public authority ever purchased a Mosquito device?**
- 2. If yes, how many Mosquito devices were purchased by your local authority?**
- 3. When were the Mosquito devices purchased?**
- 4. If known, where were the devices used?**
- 5. What has been done with the Mosquito's if they are no longer in use? Where are they now?**

No, the Council has never purchased or used such a device. At the time the devices first came out members were not in favour of such and therefore was never progressed for use in our city.
