You have requested the following information:

Please can you provide me with the following information:

- 1) Total gross sundry debt arrears for 2011/12
- 2) Total Bad Debt provision for 2011/12

My enquires can confirm :

1. Sundry Income owed at 13 March 2012 was £6,350,317.88. This figure constitutes all charges owed that are 1 day or more overdue.
2. As published in the Council's Statement of Account for 2011/12 - £16.348m
