Thank you for requesting information about stray and surrendered greyhounds, which the Council received on 5 June 2013. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You have requested the following information;

We are interested in the following information for January 2006 through present.

Please provide any documents and statistics on stray and surrendered greyhounds (or any collected by animal control), the disposition of those dogs, their ear tattoos if available, and any investigations and complaints regarding greyhound breeding farms, kennels, training facilities, and greyhound racing tracks. A list of licensed greyhound kennels in the borough.

Since January 2006, the Council's Animal Welfare service has dealt with zero stray or surrendered greyhounds that have been connected to greyhound racing or breeding.

There are no registered greyhound racing tracks or breeders within the local authority area and no complaints have been received regarding such matters.

Please note that most of the information that you request is owned by the Coventry City Council and subject to copyright protection. 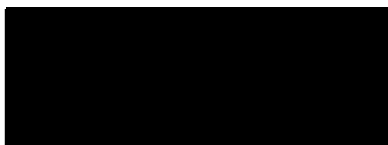
