

CITY COUNCIL NOTICES

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS GIBBET HILL ROAD

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended), has made a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit driving of any vehicles on Gibbet Hill Road between its junctions with Kenilworth Road and Westwood Heath Road from 07.00 hours on Monday, 11th February 2008, to allow a gas main to be installed in the carriageway safely.

The road closure will be implemented in stages along the length of Gibbet Hill Road. The existing "prohibition of driving" order on Library Road, at its junction with Gibbet Hill Road, will be revoked for the duration of the works to allow access to the university.

The maximum duration of this order is eighteen months but it is envisaged that the proposed works will take twenty weeks and the order will thereafter be revoked.

An alternative route is available via Kenilworth Road, A45 Fletchamstead Highway, Sir Henry Parkes Road, Kirby Corner Road and Gibbet Hill Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained as normal.

Access for properties on the closed section of road will be maintained except for the period of time when work is being carried out directly in front of the property.

Exemptions will be provided for emergency and local authority vehicles and vehicles being used in connection with the works.

MITCHELL AVENUE

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended), has made a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit driving of any vehicles on Mitchell Avenue, between its junction with Charter Avenue and its cul-de-sac end from 07.00 hours on Monday, 11th February 2008, to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken safely.

The maximum duration of this order is eighteen months but it is envisaged that the proposed works will take six weeks and the order will thereafter be revoked.

An alternative route for vehicular traffic to Thomas Sharp Street is available via Charter Avenue, Wolfe Road and Keele Road. An alternative route for vehicular traffic to Wendiburgh Street is available via Charter Avenue and John Rouse Avenue. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Exemptions will be provided for emergency and local authority vehicles and vehicles being used in connection with the works.

Access to properties on the closed section of road will be maintained except for the period of time when work is being carried out directly in front of the property.
