**Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA)**

Thank you for requesting information about the Charterhouse Residents Parking Scheme, which the Council received on 4 September 2014 and has considered it under the above legislation.

You have requested the following information;

*I require information on challenges made in the Charterhouse residents parking scheme.*

- I would like to know how many challenges to PCN s have been made in each year since Coventry implemented decriminalised Parking Enforcement in 2005 I think and how many if these have been successful.*
- Of the successful challenges I would like to know a breakdown of numbers of those which were allowed because they would have fitted in one of the 8 grounds allowed for in the formal challenges - (these are available on the council making representations form) and number allowed which did not fit any of these categories but were successful under the any other reason category which would require council discretion.*
- Of those allowed for under the council discretion I would appreciate a brief summary of the reason the challenge was allowed.*

It has been established that the Council does not hold the above information and therefore are unable to provide it. We are informing you as required by Section 1(1) (a) FOIA. Parking Services recently updated their database, unfortunately not all the data converted across to the new system as a result they are unable to provide any of the information requested.
