Coventry City Council ("the Council"), in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by regulation 17 of the Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000¹ ("the 2000 Regulations") hereby gives you a notice as follows-

The Council has decided to vary the conditions of permit reference **081** granted under regulation 9(1) of the 2000 Regulations in respect of the operation of the installation at:

The variation of the conditions of the permit and date on which they are to take effect are specified in Schedule 1 to this notice. A consolidated permit as varied by this notice is set out in Schedule 2.

In Document A, Permit, Page 1 delete the words:	Immediately
"plans PPC/081/A, PPC/081/B"	
and replace with:	
"plan PPC/081/A"	
In Document A, Permit, Page 3 delete the words:	Immediately
"Plan PPC/081/B shows the layout of the key plant on site referred to in this permit."	
In Document B, Materials Handling and Storage, Clause 5.2 delete the words:	Immediately
" indicated on plan PPC/081/B"	
In Document B, Emission Limits, Clause 1.1 delete the words:	Immediately
"shall not exceed 100 mg/m³"	
and replace with:	
"shall not exceed 50 mg/m ³ "	
In Document B, General Conditions, Clause 7.5 delete the words:	Immediately
"The operator shall undertake regular cleaning and preventative maintenance including inspection and repair/replacement on all plant and equipment concerned with the emission,	

capture, transport and control of emissions to atmosphere. Where necessary manufacturers guidelines shall be used to determine the regularity of maintenance. Records of preventative maintenance including inspections and any works undertaken shall be kept on site and made available to the local authority inspector on request."

and replace with:

"Effective preventative maintenance shall be employed on all aspects of the activity including all plant, buildings and the equipment concerned with the control of emissions to air. In particular; a written maintenance programme shall be available to the regulator with respect to pollution control equipment, and a record of such maintenance shall be made available for inspection by the regulator."

In Document B, General Conditions, Clause 7.7 delete the words:

"Staff at all levels shall receive the necessary training and instruction in their duties relating to control of the activities and emissions to air. Records shall be kept which details all relevant training provided to staff, and these records shall be kept for a minimum of 2 years."

and replace with:

"The operator shall maintain a statement of training requirements for each operational post and keep a record of the training received by each person whose actions may have an impact on the environment. These documents shall be made available to the regulator on request."

In Document B, General Conditions, insert the following Clause 7.9:

"The training of all staff with responsibility for operating the activity shall include:

- awareness of their responsibilities under the Permit; in particular how to deal with conditions likely to give rise to emissions, such as in the event of spillage;
- minimising emissions on start up and shut down; and
- action to minimise emissions during abnormal conditions."

In Document B, General Conditions, insert the following Clause 7.10:

"Operators shall put in place some form of structured environmental management system (EMS), whether by adopting published standards (ISO 14001 or the EU Eco Management and Audit Scheme [EMAS]) or by setting up an EMS tailored to the nature and size of the particular process."

In appendix, remove document titled:

"Plan PPC/081/A showing general area and installation boundary of Coventry Roadstone Site"

and replace with document titled:

"Plan PPC/081/A Premises Boundary of Coventry Roadstone"
