








#### **KS1: Percent attaining Level 2+**



#### **KS3: Percent attaining Level 5+**




#### **KS2: Percent attaining Level 4+**





#### **KS2 English: Percent attaining Level 4+**




#### **KS2 Mathematics: Percent attaining Level 4+**







#### **KS3 Science: Percent attaining Level 5+**




#### **KS3 ICT: Percent attaining Level 5+**



## **KS4 GCSE/GNVQ: Average Total Points** attained by Y11 Students (uncapped)






