### **Eligibility Criteria**

Funded Early Education for Two Year Old Children

#### Apply for Two Year Old Funding

Here you can apply to receive a funded place of up to 15 hours a week for your two year old. If successful, you will receive a Two Year Old Funding voucher that you can take to a Childcare Provider like a Nursery or Childminder that offers funded places for two year olds.

#### Eligibility Route 1 Claim

Here you can make an application through Eligibility Route 1

A child is eligible through Eligibility Route 1 if their parent is in receipt of any of the following UK benefits;

- · Income Support
- · Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Employment & Support Allowance ESA (Income Related)
- Receiving support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Seeker Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit only at a rate higher than the Family Element Child Tax Credit must be higher than £535.00 per annum and household income less than £16,190 per annum Award Notice TC602.
- Working Family Tax Credits and have an annual gross earnings of no more than £16.190 per year
- · Extra Working Tax Credit relating to a Disability
- · Pension Credit (Guarantee Element) and proof of Child Tax Credit

#### Eligibility Route 2 Claim

Here you can apply for Two Year Old Funding through Eligibility Route 2.

Please only apply through this route after seeing if the application is not possible through the Eligibility Route 1 criteria.

A child who falls into one of the following categories would also be eligible:


- Is in the care of the local authority. Evidence A letter from a relevant professional with the child's name and date of birth.
- Has left care through special guardianship, adoption or residence order:
   Evidence 2 year old funding letter from LA with child's name and date of birth or special guardianship, adoption or residence order from the court.
- Has a current statement of Special Educational Need or an Education, Health and Care Plan. Evidence – A letter from a relevant professional working with the family regarding the EHCP awarded.
- Has a diagnosed syndrome, condition or disability that significantly affects ability to access learning or Has a delay of at least 6 months in 2 or more areas of development. Evidence – A letter from a relevant professional working with the family regarding the SEN criteria listed.
- Attracts Disability Living Allowance (DLA). Evidence Award letter for DLA.
- Has a Child Protection Plan (CPP). Evidence Letter from a relevant professional regarding the CPP with child's name and date of birth.
- Is being supported through the Common Assessment Framework (CAF) process. Evidence - Letter from relevant professional regarding the CAF with child's name and date of birth.

Once you have received notification of a successful claim, you can print or take the details of the voucher on your mobile device to an approved childcare provider to check if a place is available for your child. Please note that not all childcare providers will offer this so be sure to check this first.

You may want to use the **Coventry Family Information service** to search for providers that offer two year old funding places.


If you have applied through Eligibility Route 1 and your claim is unsuccessful, you may be able to

- apply for funding through Eligibility Route 2 if any conditions in that criteria apply to your child









#### **FAQs**

#### I have filled in the online form to register but have not yet received an email

 It is possible that the email has been quarantined by anti-spam measures taken by your Internet Service Provider or by settings in your mail client.

Check to make sure that, if you are an Outlook/Outlook Express user, the relevant email has not been mis-identified as "junk" and deposited in the Junk folder. If the email has definitely not been delivered to you then contact your Internet Service Provider to see whether the email can be tracked and its fate discovered.
