In the car of today, electronics and connected technology make up over half of the value, and autonomous technologies are increasingly commonplace. Local companies here are at the forefront of driving forward these new technologies.

You're in Good Company

This is the home of the global HQ and R&D centres for Aston Martin Lagonda, Jaguar Land Rover and Geely London Taxi Company. The area is also home to R&D centres for a number of other OEM Vehicle makers and tier 1 suppliers active in CAV, including Bosch, Denso, Siemens, Telent and Volvo.

Together with expertise in R&D, powertrain, prototyping, software and manufacture, the area hosts a number of OEMs involved in the connected vehicle supply chain. Horiba-MIRA is a global leader in the development and deployment of CAV technology from its base at Nuneaton, Warwickshire. The site has 100km of road that includes a range of highway layouts to simulate real world scenarios.

Coventry's RDM Group is a pioneer of autonomous vehicles. Its driverless Lutz Pathfinder pod has attracted global interest, and is being extensively trialled in the UK.

Ideas & Innovation

Centre for Connected and Autonomous Vehicles at Coventry University works with industry to provide research capabilities in new HMI and human centre design, autonomous systems and security threat analysis.

iCentrum Intelligent Mobility Incubator (Innovation Birmingham) is for Tech start-ups developing innovative new concepts within the field of Intelligent Mobility co-located with business support from mentors within the sector.

MIRA Technology Park is a transport technologies focused UK Enterprise Zone featuring a campus style environment for R&D activity, with many companies active in connected & autonomous vehicle research.

WMG at the University of Warwick is working with the auto industry on low carbon vehicle and connected & autonomous vehicle research.

CAV and Intelligent Mobility – Key Projects

UK Autodrive - A £19.3m, 3 year project bringing together 12 private, public and university partners to develop and deploy driverless technologies on the streets of Milton Keynes and Coventry & Warwickshire. Private partners include Jaguar Land Rover, Ford and RDM Group.

UK Connected Intelligent Transport Environment (UKCITE) - £7.1m project to enable automotive, infrastructure and service companies to trial connected vehicle technology, infrastructure and services on roads in Coventry and Warwickshire.
