## Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request ID: REQ05997

Thank you for your request for information relating to road projects.

Your request and our responses are outlined below:

I am requesting information relating to road/highway projects (e.g. roundabout improvements, new roads and junctions, major road resurfacing) funded or contributed to by your council from its capital budget and budgeted to cost over £500,000 or more.

I require data relating to any applicable projects carried out during the tax periods of 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-present date. Of such projects, please provide the following information:

• Project name or description (e.g. Bell Lane roundabout improvements, M1 Junction XX works)

- Start date
- Planned delivery date
- Actual delivery date
- Planned budget
- Actual spend

I can confirm the information on the Council's capital programme is contained in an annual report to the Cabinet in February of each year. The Cabinet papers can be viewed using the following link:

The main body of the report will also contain updates on the major projects being delivered by the Council.

With specific regard to highways and transport schemes valued at more than £500,000 that have been delivered in 2017/18 and 2018/19, or which are in the process of being delivered during 2019/20, I would highlight the following:

- A4053 Coventry Ring Road Swanswell Viaduct Major Maintenance scheme [completed 2018/19] Phase One [Note: Phase Two is currently unfunded].
- A45 / A4114 Junction Improvement installation of traffic signals at existing grade-separated junction [completed 2018/19].
- Coventry City Centre Public Realm Scheme Phase 4 public realm improvements within the city centre [to be [completed 2019/20]
- Coventry City Centre Public Realm Scheme Phase 5 @£40 million package of public realm improvements in the city centre [Upper and Lower Precinct, Smithford Way, Market Way, Greyfriars Lane and Queen Victoria Road]. Commenced 2019/20, completion due in 2020/21.
- Coventry Railway Station Masterplan £82 million scheme including a new Car Park at the Station. Commenced 2018/19, completion due 2020/21.
- A45 Eastern Green Junction a new £13 million junction serving a new housing development West of Coventry. Programmed for commencement in 2020, completion in 2021/22.
- Salt Lane Car Park a new multi-storey car park replacing an existing surface car park. Completion due in 2019/20.
- A45 Whitley South infrastructure connected with a new development at the JLR plant south of the city. Programmed for commencement in 2020/21.
