## **SLAVERY IS WRONG.**

## You know it. We know it.

## Let's do something about it together by knowing the warning signs.

Individual appears fearful of police/authorities
Exhibits signs of psychological trauma e.g anxiety, lack of memory
Unaware they have been trafficked and believe they are
simply in a bad job

Limited freedom of movement and are unable to leave their place of work

Have no identity documents in their personal possession, and little or no finances of their own Have limited access to medical care

Seem to be in debt to someone

Are women/men being moved between brothels or to other work locations?

Do the people selling sex also appear to be living in the property too?

This is not usual for a brothel.

Does the individual selling sex have an English vocabulary of sexualised words?

Are there CCTV cameras at the entrance to the property.

Do you see a bank of mobile phones with numbers written

on the back of them?

Is the person selling sex closely guarded? Do they have any untreated injuries? e.g cigarette burns, marks under arms or behind ears?

Do the individuals look like they are taking cose from someone?

Is there a distinct lack of home furnishings that you'd expect in a residential property?

If there are locks on the doors, are there scratches or marks from the inside where someone has been trying to open them?

Is there evidence that the individual has been

forced/coerced/intimidated into providing sexual services?
