Thank you for your request for information relating to birth data.

You have requested the following information:

Live Birth Data for Coventry primary schools by priority area for school starting year 2020. Could you also provide this data for 2021 and 2022.

I would like to see a list of each primary school catchment area and how many children are of the birth year and would potentially be applying for primary school in September 2020 intake if they stuck to their catchment area.

The schools I'm Particular concerned with are:

Walsgrave Church of England Primary School Potters Green Primary School Clifford Bridge Primary School

Birth data is gathered bi-annually from the NHS Trust that covers Coventry, the South Warwickshire Foundation Trust. The most recent data collection was 05 September 2019, therefore the information provided is correct as of that date. This trust gathers information on all pre-school children registered to a GP in this trust. Coventry Local Authority geocode this information into school catchment to arrive at the table below.

With this information being provided as at 05 September 2019, the transient nature of Coventry pupils, and movement of pupils both in and out of the city, the number of children being registered in each catchment area may change.

To avoid double counting of pupils, only schools with a catchment area have been included in this response, with schools which do not operate traditional catchment areas (faith based schools, and free schools) being excluded from our response.
