- 5.Please provide the average weekly fee (average weekly support cost) for adults with a diagnosis of Prader-Willi Syndrome living in supported living.

6.Please provide a list of the providers with which adults with a diagnosis of Prader-Willi Syndrome are living (please include both supported living and care home providers).
