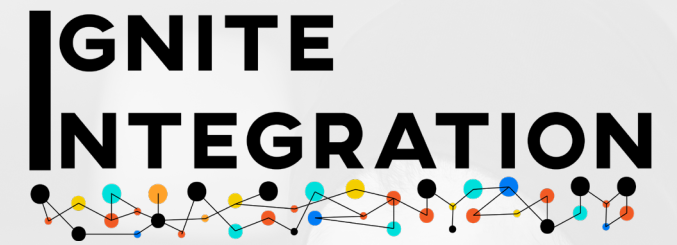

Our Mission

The Ignite Integration Programme supports refugees and migrants along their integration journey by offering holistic support identified through the Integrass Assessment Toolkit, be that gaining confidence in the community, becoming more independent, receiving employability or language training, or securing employment.

With organisations like your own adopting our programme's toolkit, we can also work collaboratively towards building a bespoke framework for Coventry (based on the Central Government's Indicators for Integration, 2019). Through this, we can better understand the needs of the city and bring in external resources to improve services and deliver innovative interventions that enable everyone to contribute and benefit.

The INTEGRASS Toolkit

The Integrass toolkit takes a holistic approach to integration that aims, to support the journey of migrants and refugees and inform the city of potentially unidentified barriers and put Coventry at the forefront for securing future funding opportunities

It considers the knowledge, competence, skills, education and experience of migrants and refugees, with a focus on self-reflection.

By identifying barriers to migrants' and refugees' social and economic integration, tailored 'personal integration plans' can be generated to compliment your existing services, outcomes and objectives.

The Benefits of the Programme

The Ignite Integration Programme targets refugees and migrants who:

- Face multiple barriers to economic and social integration including, but not limited to, trauma, mental health problems, low levels of confidence, living in isolated communities
- Have lower levels of English language attainment and education achievement

Benefits for the Wider Community:

- Enhanced contribution to the economic growth of the city
- Increased social capital for refugees and migrants who can feel isolated, leading to mental health problems
- Improved language skills, confidence and independence of migrants and refugees – reducing impact on public services
- Strengthened relationships between newly arrived and host communities, leading to improved community cohesion
