Please could you tell me the total value of recoverable overpayments made to staff and the total value of non-recoverable overpayments made to staff for the last five financial years, including the current financial year? Could you also include the number of instances the recoverable/non-recoverable overpayments were made?

## Please note:

- The table provided records the overall total of overpayments and recoveries for the core Council (i.e. does not include data for schools)
- We also advise that the data for the current financial year is not yet complete
- It can be seen from the data that over the past four years recovery rates have been consistently above 95%.
- Robust processes are in place for recovering amounts. For current employees
  these amounts are taken directly from salaries, for leavers we negotiate repayment
  plans, using our sundry income team and the courts where it is a financially viable
  option.
