Thank you for your request for information relating to spend on hotels for homeless.

You have requested the following information:

Please could you tell me how much money was spent by the local authority on Travelodge/Premier Inn/Holiday Inn accommodation for homeless people in each month of 2018 and 2019.

Please provide figures for each hotel chain, for each month, of the two year period.

We can confirm that we do not hold this information and are advising you as per Section 1(1) of the Act.

Coventry City Council currently commission the Salvation Army for the responsibility of a number of single homeless individuals across the city, including in many cases, the placement of individuals in temporary accommodation. The information regarding the bookings is therefore held by the Salvation Army as they are responsible for administering this provision.

For information, we publish a variety of information such as: <u>FOI/EIR Disclosure Log</u>, <u>Publication Scheme</u>, <u>Facts about Coventry</u> and <u>Open Data</u> that you may find of useful if you are looking for information in the future.
