Extended Entitlement (30 Hours) Validity Checks







Key Information

- Parents can apply when their child is aged 2 years and 36 weeks
- Foster Carers may be eligible subject to agreement with Social Care
- Parents obtaining a code for the first time must do so before the 31st August, 31st December or 31st
 March
- Eligible parents receive an 11 digit eligibility code which is valid for 3 months
- The Provider must ensure the Parent and Carer Agreement is fully completed prior to the child's details being added onto the portal to meet UK GDPR requirements
- Providers **must** validate the code using the Coventry Schools and Early Years Portal. Providers **must** check the **eligible from** date prior to allowing a child to commence a place
- A code will only be valid from the start of the term after it was approved
- If a child remains at the same provider, they can continue 30 hours during the Grace Period



Key Information

- Providers must regularly check the Coventry Schools and Early Years Portal to clarify validity dates of codes and remind parents to reconfirm
- It is a parent's responsibility to re-confirm their code every 3 months when prompted by HMRC or the school / childcare provider in order to remain eligible
- Please be aware that parents may need to reconfirm their code prior to a child accessing a funded place for the first time
- Parents who do not reconfirm their code, automatically become ineligible and will therefore enter into a grace period
- Once a child enters a grace period, they **cannot** begin a place with a new school or provider
- Parents may fall out of eligibility if their employment circumstances change
- Parents cannot claim 30 hours funded childcare once their child starts a Reception Class place

The Department for Education (DfE) provides an Eligibility Checking System (ECS) to allow you to check online and in real time the validity of eligibility codes issued by HMRC to working parents eligible for 30 Hours Free Childcare. You many only perform checks where the parent/carer has given consent for you to do so and when they have agreed that this check information can be shared with the Local Authority and any other providers the child attends.

Useful Information

Please note that a child cannot start a new 30 hour place in their Grace Period. If they remain at the same provider they can continue to claim 30 hours when in their grace period. Please check the **Eligible from** date when running a new check, if the code starts in the current term then the child cannot take up a 30 hour place until the following term. All applications for the 30 hour entitlement must be completed in the previous term.


Error messages will appear under a box if the wrong format is entered into the boxes for Child's Date of Birth, Parent's NI Number and the 11 digit Eligibility Code.

The 'Find a child' box will only work after the child has been submitted into at least one headcount task after a validity check and the child's record is held in the system.

If this is a new child and you are getting "No Results", then press the "Child Not Found" button at the bottom and it will allow you to add the child as new and continue the checking process.




Provider Portal – Running a new validation check


An unsuccessful validation will return a message like this. At this point, you may want to recheck the details given to you by the parent or carer to ensure they have been entered correctly.


