

What is a Safeguarding Adult Review?



A Safeguarding Adult
Review is when people look
at how well everyone worked
together to keep someone
safe.

Why do we do Safeguarding Adult Reviews?



Because the Law tells us we have to.



So, we can learn, make changes and do things better in the future.

Who will do the Review?



The review will be done by people who are not involved and who know what good work is.



They may be people from the Council or the police or health.

How will we do the review?



We will have meetings.



We will ask people to write reports.



We will ask someone who does not know the case to help us see how we can learn and get better at what we do.

How can you help us?



You can tell us what you think.

How long will the review process take?



It can take a long time - about 6-9 months.



We will always keep you up to date with what is happening.

What happens when the review is finished?



A report will be written.



The report will be shared with lots of people so that changes in practice can be introduced, where necessary.



The report might be put onto the internet so that others can learn too.
