

Notice of Intent

Proposed Road Humps (Raised Tables)
Coundon Cycleway

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Highways Act 1980, intends to install road humps (raised tables) of no more than 90mm high at the following locations:

Duncroft Avenue	- 17m south east of its northernmost junction with Norman Place Road
Hollyfast Road	- at the entrance to the south eastern section of Hollyfast Road at its junction with Westhill Road
Elmwood Avenue	- at its entrance, north east of its junction with Barkers Butts Lane
Ashwood Avenue	- at its entrance, north east of its junction with Barkers Butts Lane
Browett Road	- south west of its junction with Barkers Butts Lane
Duckham Court	- at its entrance, south west of its junction with Barkers Butts Lane
Stanier Avenue	- at its entrance, south west of its junction with Coundon Road
Chester Street	- south west of its junction with Coundon Road
Meriden Street	- south west of its junction with Coundon Road
Barras Lane	- south west of its junction with Coundon Road

The proposed traffic calming features should reduce vehicle speeds and will assist to improve road safety. The raised tables will also allow the Coundon cycle track to continue at the same level across these side roads, rather than the cycleway and footway dropping down to road level at the junction. This further enforces the change in priority to cycles over vehicles and also provides priority for pedestrians.
