

Notice of Intent

Proposed Installation of Controlled Crossings - Coundon Cycleway

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install controlled crossings on the following roads.

Hollyfast Road	Parallel crossing to be located on Hollyfast Road approximately 22m south east of its junction with Norman Place Road
Scots Lane	Parallel crossing to be located on Scots Lane approximately 6m north of its roundabout junction with Westhill Road
Barkers Butts Lane	Controlled cycle crossing to be located on Barkers Butts Lane approximately 25m north west of its junction with Browett Road

A parallel crossing is a controlled crossing for use by both pedestrians and cyclists. The parallel crossing uses the zebra crossing layout for pedestrians, with a cycle route marked alongside. The proposed parallel crossings should assist both pedestrians and cyclists to cross the road.

The proposed controlled cycle crossing is a signalised crossing to assist cyclists to cross the road. It is proposed on Barkers Butts Lane at a location where a proposed 2 way cycle track transfers from one side of the road to the other.

The works are part of the Coundon Cycleway, a scheme proposed as part of the Local Air Quality Action Plan, to encourage people to walk and cycle rather than drive. The works should assist to improve access and safety and be completed by the end of Summer 2021.
