

CITY OF COVENTRY (BROWETT ROAD) (NO ENTRY) ORDER 2020

Coventry City Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order

1. This Order shall come into operation on the **XXth day of XXXX** 2020 and may be cited as the "City of Coventry (Browett Road) (No Entry) Order 2020".
2. i) In this Order
 - a) reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this Order so numbered
 - b) "cause" includes permit and causing shall be construed accordingly
 - c) "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bylaw, rule, regulation, scheme or instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of a subsequent enactment;
 - d) "vehicle" means:-
 - i) a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the road; and/or
 - ii) a pedal cycle in actual use for the purposes of cycling
 - iii) "vehicle", which shall for the avoidance of doubt include the whole or any part of a vehicle.
 - e) the following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them:-

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning ascribed to it as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

 - (ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall ride or drive or cause or permit any vehicle to enter Browett Road from Barkers Butts Lane.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle listed in the First Schedule to this Order.
5. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be read and construed as not being in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Nothing in Articles of this Order shall apply to any:-

- (a) vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance service purposes in the circumstances of an emergency.
- (b) Pedal cycle
- (c) Vehicle being used for:-
 - (i) The removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (ii) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road
 - (iii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus.
- (d) Vehicle being used in accordance with any indication given by a traffic sign which has been placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Act.
