

CITY OF COVENTRY (DUNCROFT AVENUE & NORMAN PLACE ROAD)
(ONE WAY) ORDER 2020

Coventry City Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order

1. This Order shall come into operation on the **XXth day of XXXX 2020** and may be cited as the "City of Coventry (Duncroft Avenue & Norman Place Road)(One Way) Order 2020".
2. i) In this Order
 - a) reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this Order so numbered
 - b) "cause" includes permit and causing shall be construed accordingly
 - c) "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bylaw, rule, regulation, scheme or instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of a subsequent enactment;
 - d) "Plan" means drawing number 1505/CCC/217 attached to this Order
 - e) "vehicle" means:-
 - i) a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the road; and/or
 - ii) a pedal cycle in actual use for the purposes of cycling
 - iii) "vehicle", which shall for the avoidance of doubt include the whole or any part of a vehicle.
 - f) the following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them:-

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning ascribed to it as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

(ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall ride or drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the lengths of road listed in the First Schedule to this Order other than in the direction specified.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle listed in the Second Schedule to this Order.
5. Any existing Traffic Regulation Order or similar instrument which imposes a prohibition of any type of vehicle on the sections of road detailed in the First Schedule is hereby revoked to the same extent with effect from the date of this Order.
6. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be read and construed as not being in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

FIRST SCHEDULE

One Way

Road in the City of Coventry	Direction in which travel permitted
Duncroft Avenue , from its northern most junction with Norman Place Road to a point approximately 13 metres south of the aforementioned junction	Southerly direction
Norman Place Road , from its southern junction with Duncroft Avenue to its junction with the main carriageway of Norman Place Road	South westerly direction.

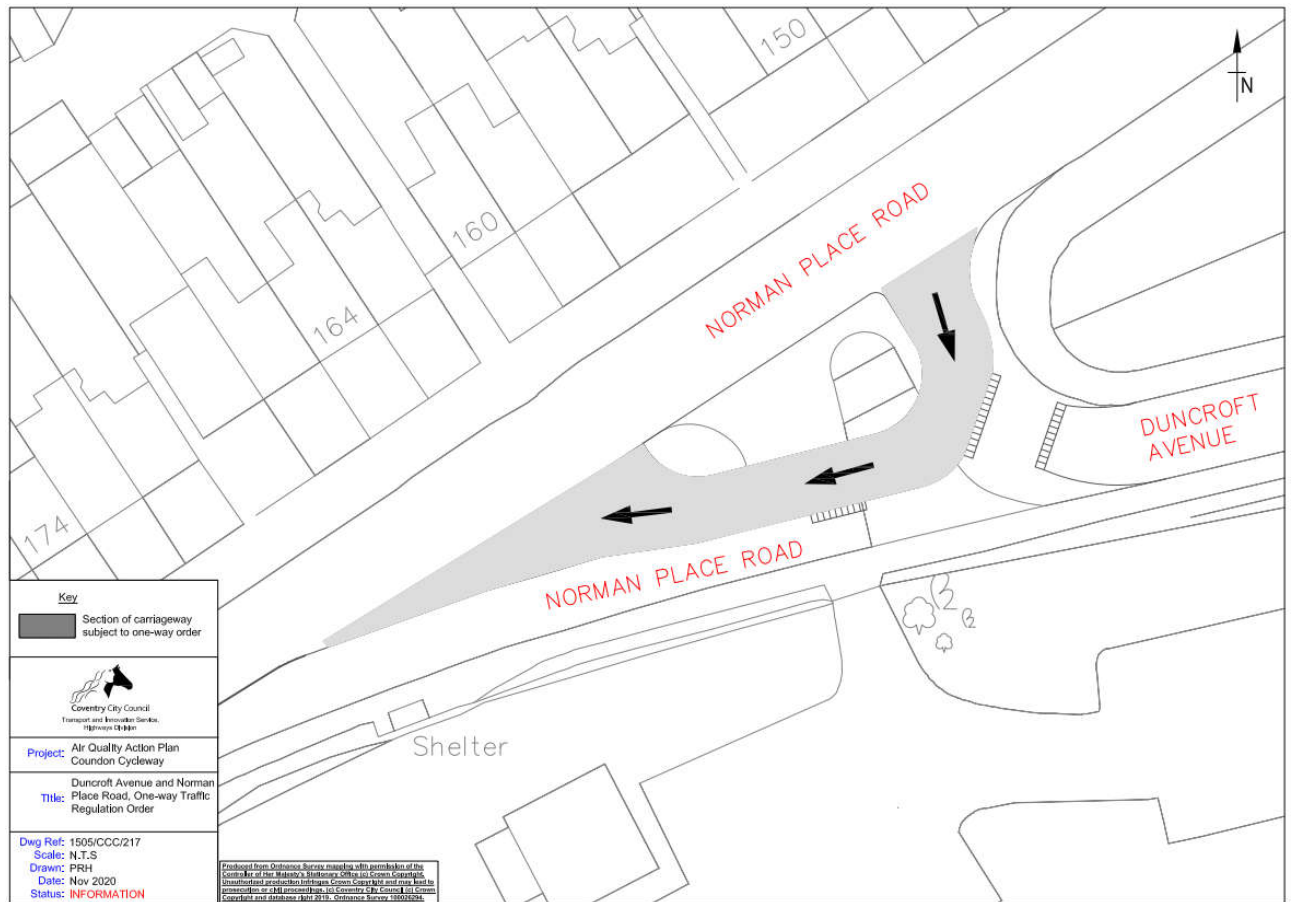

SECOND SCHEDULE

Nothing in Articles of this Order shall apply to any:-

- a) Vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance service purposes in the circumstances of an emergence.
- b) Action done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
