- Help businesses make permanent switches from petrol/Diesel to Electric


Greenhouse gas emissions from transport

28% of greenhouse gas emissions were

from transport in 2018

Transport was the largest emitting sector of UK greenhouse gas emissions in 2018






Electric fleet of up to 70 vehicles:

- 60% electric vans
- 30% electric cars
- 10% electric taxis

Why the interest in vans?

- Van use has increased more than any other vehicle class over the long term
- Vast majority are diesel-fuelled, contributing to NO₂ pollution
- Vans are disproportionately polluting
 - 33% of NOx emissions (98,000 tonnes in 2016) from vans from only 16% of road traffic
- Zero emission alternatives available and viable for many




- 2 month trial
