

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Princethorpe Way, Quorn Way & Bredon Avenue Area) **(20mph Zone & Consolidation) Order 2021**

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

In response to residents' road safety concerns it is proposed to extend the existing 20mph zone on Princethorpe Way, Quorn Way and associated side roads to include part of Bredon Avenue and the side roads abutting it. The general effect of this proposal will be to maintain the existing 20mph speed limits within the area and restrict vehicular traffic from travelling at speeds greater than 20mph on the lengths of roads listed below, currently subject to national speed limit (30mph on a street lit road).
