#OurHillfields working together to build a safer Hillfields



Hillfields is a diverse, young and exciting community close to Coventry's historic city centre.

At the West Midlands Violence Reduction Unit (WM VRU - see end of booklet for more information about us) we want to celebrate the people and positive stories of Hillfields and in particular, the creativity and contributions of our young people.

We also want to address the things that are holding Hillfields back from being an even stronger community, such as violence, substance misuse, deprivation, inequality, and exploitation.

We first began work in Coventry in December 2019, setting up a 'place-based pilot project' in Hillfields. The pilot is designed to test different methods to assess which are effective in reducing serious violence among young people and the community. Now referred to as #OurHillfields, the project brings together police and local authorities with charitable organisations, businesses, community members, and young people to share knowledge and expertise about how to make Hillfields a safer place to live.

Over the last year, the WM VRU has commissioned projects such as Early Years Protective Behaviours programmes, school and community-based youth mentoring, and domestic abuse prevention campaigns. However, the VRU cannot meet its objectives without the support and participation of local people, many of whom are already doing great things for their community. We exist to support and extend this work, enabling and empowering local people to help Hillfields thrive.



Introduction to the West Midlands Violence Reduction Unit

Established in 2019. the West Midlands Violence Reduction Unit (WM VRU) is a partnership organisation that sits within the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. It aims to reduce and prevent violent crime across the region.

It benefits from the expertise of partners in public health, criminal justice, sports, education, and policing to tackle the root causes of violence and support communities most affected by violence.

Serious Violence in the West Midlands has followed the national trend and has risen consistently for a number of years. It has led to an increased fear of crime, a rise in the mental and physical injuries suffered by members of our community and many untimely deaths. However, we believe that violence is preventable, not inevitable.

The WM VRU is committed to working with local community members and young people to reduce vulnerability and prevent crime. We do this by taking a 'public health approach' to violence reduction as explained below:

Prevention

Prevention is better than cure The best way to reduce violence is to try and stop it from happening in the first place.

We need to learn from scientists and health professionals who treat violence like a disease which has identifiable root causes

If these causes are addressed from an early age, we can help stop the spread of violence amongst our children and young people.
