Thank you for your request for information relating to Website software for developing and publishing online forms.

Your request and our responses are shown below:

1. Do you use online forms for residents to complete using a web browser? Yes.

2. Approximately how many online forms do you have?

We currently have 644 forms published in our forms system. This includes both external forms via our website and internal forms via our intranet. Approximately 33% of them are internal only.

3. What 3rd party or in-house software do you use to develop your online forms. This may be different from the software used to publish your website.
