Thank you for your request for information relating to Looked after children in unregulated accommodation.

Your request and our responses are shown below:

Between the 6th January 2019 and 9th December 2020 (703 days):

1. How many looked after children Under 18 who you have placed in unregulated and/or unregistered accommodation for any time period anywhere in the United Kingdom, have you received a safeguarding concern about during the time frame above?

A total of 17 looked after children under 18 who were placed in unregulated accommodation (supported accommodation) between 06/01/19 - 09/12/20 were the subject of a Contact during their placement.

2. Please provide the following information in a redacted format where necessary, the type of safeguarding concern as defined by the list in the guidance notes (below)

*For the categories of Bullying and Cyberbullying, Grooming, Non-recent abuse and Online abuse, we hold the information which you have asked for but we have estimated that the cost of meeting this part of your request would exceed the cost limit of £450 specified in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees Regulations 2004). This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 18 hours or more, in determining whether the information is held, locating, retrieving and extracting it.

We have no specific categories to identify this and therefore a manual trawl of the children's records will be necessary. Due to the high volume of records held, this piece of work would exceed the time limit for this FOI. This part of your request has therefore been refused under section 12(2) of the Act.

3. Please provide age sex and gender and ethnicity of each person. If it would help to protect identity I would be happy to receive the information in a manner that is blind to the ethnicity the child.
