TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS RELATING TO COUNDON CYCLEWAY

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the following Orders ("the Orders"), which come into operation on 1st November 2021.

The Orders form part of changes to facilitate and enhance the safety of users of the highway, particularly the Coundon Cycleway. Coundon Cycleway forms part of the Local Air Quality Action Plan, to encourage people to walk and cycle rather than drive.

The said Orders are: -

i) City of Coventry (Browett Road)(No Entry) Order 2021

The effect of this order shall be to prevent vehicles, except pedal cycles, entering Browett Road from Barkers Butts Lane.

The title of this order when originally advertised was City of Coventry (Browett Road) (No Entry) Order 2020. It has since been changed to that above.

ii) City of Coventry (Duncroft Avenue & Norman Place Road) (One Way) Order 2021

The effect of this order shall be to only permit vehicles to travel on (i) Duncroft Avenue, from its northern most junction with Norman Place Road to a point approximately 13 metres south of the aforementioned junction in a southerly direction. (ii) Norman Place Road (section of road previously bus only) from its southern junction with Duncroft Avenue to its junction with the main carriageway of Norman Place Road in a south westerly direction.

The title of this order when originally advertised was City of Coventry (Duncroft Avenue & Norman Place Road)(One Way) Order 2020. It has since been changed to that above.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder, or of any relevant Act, has not been complied with may, within six (6) weeks from today, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
