2. Please provide the total number of adults with learning disabilities funded by the Local Authority in residential care.

3. Of the total number of adults with learning disabilities funded by the Local Authority in

residential care (q.2) please provide the number that are in 'in area' placements and the number that are in 'out of area' placements.

4. Please provide the total number of adults with learning disabilities funded by the Local Authority in supported living.

5. Please provide the number of adults with learning disabilities who transitioned from children's learning disabilities services into adult's services - in total, into adult residential care services only, and into adult supported living services only.

6. Please provide the number of adults with learning disabilities who 'stepped down' from specialist inpatient hospital placements into adult residential care and supported living services.

We hold the information which you have asked for, but we have estimated that the cost of meeting your request would exceed the cost limit of £450 specified in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees Regulations 2004). This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 18 hours or more, in determining whether the information is held, locating, retrieving and extracting it.

This information is not held in a reportable format and would therefore require manual work to review every individual case file involved to collate the information. We expect this to exceed 300 hours work for the 693 clients for both timeframes. This part of your request has been refused under section 12(2) of the Act.

7. Please provide the local authority's total expenditure on residential care and supported living for adults with learning disabilities for the financial year 2020/21, and budgeted expenditure for 2021/22.

Gross expenditure 2020/21 for adults (18-64) with a learning disability in residential care was ± 10.9 m.

Gross expenditure 2020/21 for adults (18-64) with a learning disability in supported living was £9.04m.

We are unable to provide figures for 2021/21 budgeted expenditure as this we do not budget at this level.

8. Please provide the highest, lowest, and average weekly rate paid by the Local Authority for residential care placements for adults with a learning disability for each of the financial years 2020/21 and 2021/22. If the Local Authority has weekly rate bands, please also provide these.

2020/21:

Highest: \pounds 3,513.53 Lowest: \pounds 30 - this will be out contribution towards a larger cost Average: \pounds 1,28153

2021/22:

Highest: £3566.23 Lowest: £30.45 - this will be out contribution towards a larger cost Average: £1,307.59

9. Please provide the highest, lowest, and average hourly rate paid by the Local Authority for supported living placements for adults with a learning disability for each of the financial years 2020/21 and 2021/22. If the Local Authority has hourly rate bands, please also provide these.

2020/21:

Highest: £2,145.83 Lowest: £31.76 (this will be out contribution towards a larger cost) Average: £329.02

2021/22:

Highest: £2,145.83 Lowest: £32.26 (this will be out contribution towards a larger cost) Average: £342.07
