Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request ID: FOI404477737

Thank you for your request for information relating to Criteria required for removal of Double Yellow Lines.

You have requested the following information:

Please could you advise what criteria is required to remove double yellow lines from public road before a local church and community centre building.

Any request for the removal of double yellow lines is reviewed on a case-by-case basis, which takes into account road safety and the effect on the movement of traffic should the restriction be removed.

If it is determined that it is possible to remove or amend any waiting restriction, a legal process has to be undertaken to revoke/amend the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) relating to the waiting restriction. This process includes a 21-day objection period; any objections are considered by the Cabinet Member for City Services resulting in a decision with regards on how to proceed. This could be to install/amend/remove the restriction as advertised. No change is made nor is an alternative restriction proposed, as this may require the TRO process to be undertaken again.

The supply of information in response to a FOI request does not confer an automatic right to reuse the information. You can use any information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research without requiring further permission. Similarly, information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting. An exception to this is photographs. Please contact us if you wish to use the information for any other purpose.
