## PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER City of Coventry (Middleborough Road) (Two Way Cycle Lane) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The Order is proposed as part of wider cycle network proposals and will assist to improve access and safety, linking Coundon Cycleway and other future developments to the city centre.

The effect of the proposed order shall be to create a two-way cycle lane on Middleborough Road (southern side of road) from a point 77 (seventy-seven) metres west of its junction with Mill Street, to a point 127 (one hundred and twenty-seven) metres west of its junction with Mill Street.
