

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS
SPON END

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the following Traffic Regulation Orders ("the Orders").

The Orders are proposed as part of a Local Air Quality Action Plan, which includes work to reduce traffic on Holyhead Road and to direct it through a widened Spon End.

The Orders proposed are:-

i) City of Coventry (The Arches Industrial Estate Access Road) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2022

The effect of this Order shall be to prevent vehicles turning right from The Arches Industrial Estate access road on to Spon End.

ii) City of Coventry (Upper Spon Street) (Prohibition of Driving and Revocation) Order 2022

The effect of this Order shall be to i) prevent vehicles (except pedal cycles) being ridden or driven in any direction on Upper Spon Street from its junction with Spon End/Butts, to a point 4 metres east of its junction with Spon End/Butts; and ii) to revoke the one way restriction currently in effect on Upper Spon Street from its junction with Spon End/Butts to a point approximately 75 metres north east of that junction.
