

**Experimental Traffic Regulation Order**

**City of Coventry (Knights Templar Way Area) (Prohibition of Driving)**  
**(Experimental) Order 2023**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Experimental Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order"), which comes into effect on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

The Order has been proposed in response to residents' concerns about parking and driving in the Knights Templar Way area when children are being taken and/or collected from Templars Primary School. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit driving (except for permit holders) on the length of roads listed below, Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm:-

Knights Templar Way	Whole Length
Lomsey Close	Whole Length
Monks Field Close	Whole Length

Residents on the affected lengths of road can apply for permits.

The Order will be implemented initially on an experimental basis for eighteen (18) months, after which time it will be reviewed. The Council may then make the Order permanent or abandon it.
