This report has been produced by the Data Team, who work closely with Coventry schools to collect, process and analyse their school and pupil information.

The Data Team also maintains a comprehensive suite of up-to-date reports and dashboards for central service teams. In addition data is uploaded to our LA partner website <u>NEXUS Perspective Lite</u> covering attainment, progress and key demographc trends giving schools a focused view of their information with national comparison. A further website, <u>FFTASPIRE</u>, is also supported by the team showing past and estimated school and pupil attainment.




