With its CNC Punching Machine over 30 years old and starting to experience numerous mechanical problems, we approached the CW Business Support Programme for advice.

MPL Fabrications successfully received a £40,000 grant through BSP towards a new CNC machine.





Project

- MPL invested £108,000
- CW Business Support offered a £40,000 grant
- New CNC machine was bought

Results

- 2 New jobs were created
- The new machine has given them flexibility and speed up their work
- More work is completed inhouse
- Clients waiting time is now significantly shorter

CW Green Business

Programme



A comprehensive energy audit was carried out by the Green Business Programme in December 2021.

This identified a number of areas where energy efficiency improvements could be made:

- New double glazing
- Destratification fans
- Rapid-closure shutter doors











Project

- MPL invested £12,895
- CW Green Business
 Programme offered a £5,818
 grant
- New double glazing, destratification fans and rapidclosure shutter doors have been installed

Results

- Energy consumption has been reduced by 30%
- £3,000 saved annually
- Over 10 tonnes of carbon saved annually
- Project payback period of just2.5 years
