Headline Criteria Eight: Safe from Domestic Abuse



Number	Criteria	Outcome
8.1	Family affected by domestic abuse or interpersonal violence and abuse- historic, recent, current or at risk (victim)	Domestic Abuse has stopped <b>AND</b> Victim has a clear safety plan in place and knows how to seek help OR Victim has received/ receiving appropriate support
8.2	Adult in the family is a perpetrator of domestic abuse	Domestic abuse has stopped <b>AND</b> perpetrator understands crime, and impact on the victim (including children) and is engaging with perpetrator support
8.3	Child currently or historically affected by domestic abuse	Domestic abuse has stopped <b>AND</b> child feels safe at home AND child has received appropriate support
