## **Headline Criteria Ten: Financial Stability**



Number	Criteria	Outcome
10.1	Adult in the family is workless (on out of work benefits)	Adult is in work <b>OR</b> Adult has made progress to work (training, volunteering, attended job interviews) <b>OR</b> Barriers to work have been removed or reduced
10.2	Family require support with their finances and/ or have unmanaged debt	Family feel able to manage their finances AND/ OR debt is being managed or has been resolved
10.3	Young person is NEET	Young person is in education, employment, or training

## How can you Evidence the Outcome has been achieved? (Systems, methods)

Securing volunteering opportunity

Parent securing employment or increased hours in existing/ new role

Parent accessing education or training

Course completed

Debt reduced- payment plan in place

Parent/carer feedback- improvement
