

## Icon Guide

This guide provides information regarding the different icons that will appear on the Residents profile within monitor and the care delivery app.

Flags

When a flag appears on a Resident/Service Users profile picture; this means that there are planned 'Must do' actions that are due or overdue.

lcon	Description
7	Red Flag: Overdue Action
-	Yellow Flag: An action is due now
	White Flag: A must do action is due that is due soon

## Butterflies

When a Resident/Service User is identified at being at the end of their life, understanding the stage of illness is vital to deliver the right care. The appropriate stage can be selected and consequently changed on Monitor. Depending on the stage, a different colour butterfly will appear on their profile picture.

lcon	Description
X	Blue Butterfly: Stable (Years Prognosis)
	Green Butterfly: Unstable/Frequent exacerbations (months prognosis)
	Orange: Deteriorating (Weeks Prognosis)

	Red Butterfly: Dying/Terminal (days/hours prognosis)
7	Purple Butterfly: After Death

Information Icons

There are a number of additional icons that can be visible on a Resident/Service Users profile, which provide information to alert staff. The area on Monitor where the icons can be set are detailed in brackets in the table below.

lcon	Description
	Additional precautions required (Infection Register)
0	DNACPR in place (Edit Service User details section)
6	The resident has risk(s) to be aware of (Edit Service User details section)
A	Resident is in Respite Care (Edit Service User details section)
▦	Resident is in Day Care (Edit Service User details section)
	A Care Review is Overdue (Care Plan)

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A Care Review is due next week (Care Plan)
All Care Reviews are up to date (Care Plan)
Resident has a message on Relatives Gateway (Relatives Gateway)
