CITY OF COVENTRY (WATERY LANE, PARISH OF ALLESLEY) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2024

Coventry City Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2), (3), (4), 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

 This Order shall come into operation on the xxth day of Xxxxxx 2024 and may be cited as the "City of Coventry (Watery Lane, Parish of Allesley) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2024".

2. (i) In this Order:

- (a) a reference to an Article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this Order so numbered;
- (b) "cause" includes permit and "causing" shall be construed accordingly;
- (c) "enactment" means any enactment, whether public, general or local and includes any order, bylaw, rule, regulation, scheme or instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of a subsequent enactment;
- (d) "motor vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the road which, for avoidance of doubt, shall include the whole or any part of the vehicle; and
- (e) The following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them:"the 2016 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and
 General Directions 2016 and includes any enactment or re-enactment
 or amendment thereto; and
 "electrically assisted pedal cycle" has the same meaning as defined in
 The Electrically Assisted Pedal Cycle Regulations 1983 (as
 amended).
- (ii) the Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as in applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 5, 7 and 8 to this Order, no person shall ride or drive or cause or permit to be driven or ridden any motor vehicle, in any direction, in that length of Watery Lane from a point 726 metres south of its junction with Wall Hill Road to a point 9 metres north-east of its junction with Clay Lane.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6, 7 and 8 to this Order, no person shall ride or drive or cause or permit to be driven or ridden any motor vehicle, in any direction, in that length of Watery Lane from a point 304 metres south of its junction with Wall Hill Road to a point 726 metres south of its junction with Wall Hill Road.
- 5. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall apply to any organisation or to any person that is the resident, owner or proprietor of a property that is listed in the Schedule to this Order.

- 6. Nothing in Article 4 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified therein if the vehicle is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on that length of road.
- 7. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 to this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified therein if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (i) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road; the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road; the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity; or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (ii) as a vehicle in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; and / or
 - (iii) for police, fire or ambulance service purposes in circumstances of emergency
- 8. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall apply to electrically assisted pedal cycles.
- 9. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be read and construed as not being in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
