

**Notice of Intent**

**Proposed Installation of Controlled Crossings**  
**Binley Cycleway (Clifford Bridge Road)**

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install controlled crossings on Clifford Bridge Road at the following locations.

Clifford Bridge Road	Toucan crossing, replacing the existing controlled crossing (pedestrian), outside 99/101 Clifford Bridge Road
Clifford Bridge Road	Puffin crossing on Clifford Bridge Road outside 185/187 Clifford Bridge Road

The works are part of the Binley Cycleway, a scheme proposed to connect the City Centre with the University Hospital Coventry & Warwickshire and encourage people to cycle. The works should assist to improve access and safety and be completed by the end of Winter 2024.
