## CITY OF COVENTRY (TREHERNE ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN) ORDER 2025

The Council of the City of Coventry ("the Council"), in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") (as amended) and Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the Act of 2004") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into force on **XX XXXX 2025** and may be cited as the "City of Coventry (Treherne Road)(No Left Turn) Order 2025".
- 2 (i) In this Order:
  - a) a reference to an Article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this Order so numbered;
  - b) the following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them:-

"2016 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 and includes any enactment or re-enactment or amendment thereto;

"cause" includes permit and causing shall be construed accordingly

"Civil Enforcement Officer" shall have the meaning assigned by section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, reenacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"road" shall have the same meaning ascribed to it by Section 142 of the Act

"vehicle" means a mechanically and/or electrically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the Road which for the avoidance of doubt includes the whole or any part of a vehicle.

- (ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (iii) Reference to any Statutory Instrument, Act, Regulations or Order referred to in this Order shall be read and construed as the Statutory Instrument, Act, Regulations or Order as amended, varied, re-enacted or revoked.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with permission of a Police Officer in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by the Council cause or permit any vehicle travelling westwards along Burnaby Road to turn left into Treherne Road.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle listed in Schedule 1 to this Order.

5. In the event any provision of this Order conflicts or is inconsistent with any provision of any other order made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by any other enactment, the provisions of this Order shall prevail and take precedence.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

## Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to:-

- (a) pedal cycles
- (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance service purposes in circumstances of emergency
- (c) any vehicle being used for:-
  - (i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
  - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road
- (d) any vehicle being used in accordance with any indication given by a traffic sign which has been placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Act
